SOME IMPORTANT BITS OF ETIQUETTE

- Seconds should never make up their mind as to what shot they are going to play. The second should wait for the skip's instructions, before stepping onto the mat, then to obey them implicitly without suggesting an alternative shot.
- As spectator, try not to move on the bank from one rink to the other when a player delivers to this side. Wait until after the bowl is delivered and respect the bowler on the mat for his focus and concentration on the aiming point which is in your direction.
- Remember, when your bowl stops the mat belongs to the opposition, your skip should now no longer talk to you
