PLAYING POSITION.

Players are inclined to see movement from Lead to Skip as a natural promotion. This is not so. Each position has specific responsibilities in the team;

* **THE LEAD.** Very important. The lead sets the start and draws to the jack. A good lead puts pressure on the opponent. This is not a position for only beginners.

* **THE SECOND.** He follows the skip's instructions to start building the head and corrects errors of the lead. Must can draw!

* **THE THIRD.** In support of the skip, must open the head or draw. He must have skills required, draw, drive or play a pound on.

* **THE SKIP.** He must control the game, encourage the members of the team and must stay calm and be a positive influence.

Every member of the team must be able to draw. Bowls is a drawing game.

DIE GESKIEDENIS VAN ONS KLUB SOOS ONTHOU DEUR JOAN CHURCH.



Voor die stigtingsvervadering in November 1971 is n kennisgewing/ uitnodiging in Wessel van Wyk se winkel in die destydse besigheidsentrum, geplaas, gerig aan diegene wie sou belangstel in die stigting van 'n rolbalklub in destydse Verwoerdburg.

'n Donasie van 50c was betaalbaar. Onder andere verskyn die stigtingslede Piet Bell, Pieter van Heerden en Joan Church se name op die lysie en stig hulle en ander belangstellendes die klub in die destydse Stadsaal in November 1971.

Work was began on the land appropriated for the purpose by the council and the first green was built with the expertise of Eddie **Atkins**, a senior bowler from Brooklyn Bowling Club and an expert on the building of greens. Consequently the first green was named after him. He was of great service on the first men's committee and so was his wife Harriet a great help on the women's committee. Together they made a significant contribution to the new club.

Daarna is die tweede perk gebou en vernoem na n senior raadslid, Mr **Van Zyl**. Hester du Preez was die eerste President met Joan Church as sekretaresse en daarna is Joan in die stoel. Sy het nog drie keer daarna gedien as damespresident en vir een termyn ook saam met haar eggenoot Cliff wat president van die manskomitee was.



Die opening word gevier vroeg in 1972 en 'n wonderlike tee (stoelle, tafels ens is aangebring uit die huise van lede) is geniet onder die bome wat destyds skadu vir toeskouers en spelers moes gee. Etlike fondsinsamelings en donasies later en met die bystand van die stadsraad is die eerste klein klubhuis opgerig.

Almal het met liefde saamgewerk maar ons dink veral in die verband aan mense soos die Gerbers, Krugers, Bells, Greefs en vele ander (nou heengegaan), en aan die dames wat so 'n groot bydrae gemaak het soos Kotie Swart en Daff Gerber, en al hulle helpers wat met die heerlike verversings by groot toernooie roem verwerf het vir ons klub.

Ook spelers, somige wat nog lede van die klub is (ons dink bv aan dames soos Jannie de Beer, Lorraine Victor en Louise Graham, Nadine Ward) het uitgeblink as spelers op klub distrik en nasionale vlak.

Wat die administrasie van rolbal betref het Joan 'n groot bydrae gemaak.

Sy het nie net op klubvlak gedien nie maar het as Presidente van die destydse Northern Transvaal Womens Bowls Board sowel as die Northern District Womens Bowls Board en ook op die eerste bestuur van Bowls South Africa gedien.

She was the chairman of numerous tournament committees including the well known and loved All Transvaal Women's Tournament, generously sponsored by SPAR and was invited and sponsored by the international Royal Swazi hotel to run a number of highly successful tournaments in Swaziland.

Under the auspices of World Bowls she ran the successful African States tournament in Johannesburg in the early nineties. While not able to serve she was at the time nominated by Bowls South Africa to serve on the global board.

Hierdie dinamiese vrou was ook 'n uitstekende rolbalspeler, kon die lekkerste skons in die klub bak en is 'n uitstekende kok. Ek het die voorreg gehad om vir 2 seisoene saam met haar te dien op die All Transvaal Women's Tournament, waarvan sy die voorsitster was, en nodeloos om te sê, alles het klopdisselboom verloop en ons het baie komplemente ontvang. Sy was 'n uitstekende administrateur en het 'n reuse bydrae gelewer tot rolbal by Centurion rolbalklub asook rolbal op Proviniaal en op Nasionale vlak.

VAN WAAR GEHASI? JOAN CHURCH.

Joan was born and raised in Pretoria, went to school in Krugersdorp and in Wynberg. She was happily married to Cliff who passed on in 2019. They have a son and a daughter. While in Pretoria, they lived in Eldoraigne and now she lives in Cape Town.

After graduating from the university of the Witwatersrand and the College of education, she taught for some years before continuing her studies at UNISA, obtaining the BJurus and LLB (cum laude) and LLD degrees. As the most outstanding student in her final year she was awarded the Johannes Voet Medal by the Pretoria Bar Association and was admitted as an advocate of the then Supreme Court in 1975.



Her special fields of interest and expertise are Comparative Family Law, Legal Education, Indigenous Law and Gender issues and she has lectured and published extensively on these subjects, both at home and abroad. Invitations to lecture at other universities for extended periods include those from the university of Pretoria, Johannesburg, Poznan, (Poland) Aberdeen in Scotland, and in Rotterdam as well as the Open University of Shri Lanka in Colombo

Joan served, and still serves on various committees inside and outside the university, among others at Unisa Senate and Senex, chairman of the Faculty Study Committee, the centers for Indigenous Law and Aid Centre at UNISA and of the SA Society of Legal Historians as well as of the Woman's Bureau and was the South African correspondent for Uni-droit.

In the context of a broader community service she served on the then Transvaal Education Council, the South African Certification Council; the HSRC National Program for Marriage and Family Law Reform Commission. Her community commitment includes service on the national executive of Bowls SA and as elected member to both diocesan and provincial synods of the Anglican Church.

Joan was elected to serve as President of the Society of Law Teachers of South Africa from 1993 – 1994 (first woman to hold this office) and in 2000 honorary membership of the society was conferred on her.

After retirement in 2000 emeritus Professor Church was appointed as an honorary research fellow in the Department of Jurisprudence, an office she still holds, and in this capacity she has presented various papers at national and international conferences and continues to publish her research.
